### RESOLUTION TO

#### **Conduct Non-Public Meeting of the Litigation Review Committee to Discuss Attorney-Client Privileged Matters**

**WHEREAS**, based on advice of the General Counsel, the Board of Regents Litigation Review Committee has balanced the purposes served by the Open Meeting Law and by the attorney-client privilege, and determined that there is a need for absolute confidentiality to discuss litigation strategy in particular matters involving the University of Minnesota.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that in accordance with Minn. Stat. § 13D.01, Subd. 3 and 13D.05 Subd. 3(b), a non-public meeting of the Litigation Review Committee be held on Thursday, April 9, 2026, at 8:00 a.m. in the Campus View Room, 600 McNamara Alumni Center, for the purpose of discussing attorney-client privileged matters including the following:
